ABOUT HEARING VOICES GROUPS

Since their inception in the late 80s, Hearing Voices Groups have become an established and valuable source of support for people who hear voices, see visions or have other unusual sensory perceptions. They provide a safe space for people to share their experiences and find ways of making sense of, and living with, them.

There are over 180 Hearing Voices Groups in the UK, in a range of settings - including charities, user/survivorled groups, prisons, inpatient units, CAMHS, Early Intervention Services, Forensic settings and community mental health teams.

Hearing Voices Networks can be found in over 26 countries across 5 continents (including Uganda, USA, Denmark, Malaysia, Japan and Australia).

ABOUT THIS COURSE

This 3 day training course equips you with the knowledge, skills and confidence to either set up a new Hearing Voices Group or co-facilitate an existing one.

It includes:

- Exploring diverse understandings of voices, visions & 'psychosis'
- Coping strategies and pathways to recovery
- Rethinking power & empowerment
- Planning, launching & establishing safe and effective Hearing Voices Groups
- Practical group facilitation skills and problem solving
- Hearing Voices Network ethos

This course is for people with a basic understanding of **the HEARING VOICES approach**, including: People with lived experience of voices/visions, support workers, psychologists, OTs, social workers, therapists, nurses etc.
